

REQUEST TO BE PLACED ON THE CITY OF NEW LONDON’S PUBLIC NOTICE REGISTRY

I hereby request that I be included on the City of New London’s “Public Notice Registry” for the purpose of being notified of all public hearings for applications initiated by the City of New London’s Planning and Zoning Commission. I understand that:

- (a) such notification shall be limited only to those applications which (1) are initiated by the New London Planning and Zoning Commission and (2) involve amendments to the City’s Zoning Regulations, changes to the City’s Zoning Map, amendments to the City’s Subdivision Regulations, or adoption of, or amendments to, the City’s Plan of Conservation and Development;
- (b) my name and address will remain on the registry for a period of three years, after which time I may again request such inclusion for additional periods of three years; and,
- (c) in complying with these notification requirements, the Planning and Zoning Commission shall not be held civilly liable to me with respect to any act done or omitted in good faith or through a bona fide error that may occur despite reasonable procedures maintained by the Planning and Zoning Commissions to prevent such errors.
