**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW LONDON, CONNECTICUT,
PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE COLUMBUS STATUE LOCATED
IN COLUMBUS SQUARE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEW LONDON:

Section 1. That the statue of Christopher Columbus be removed from Columbus Square.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective after its passage as set forth in Section 27 of the City of New London Charter.
